

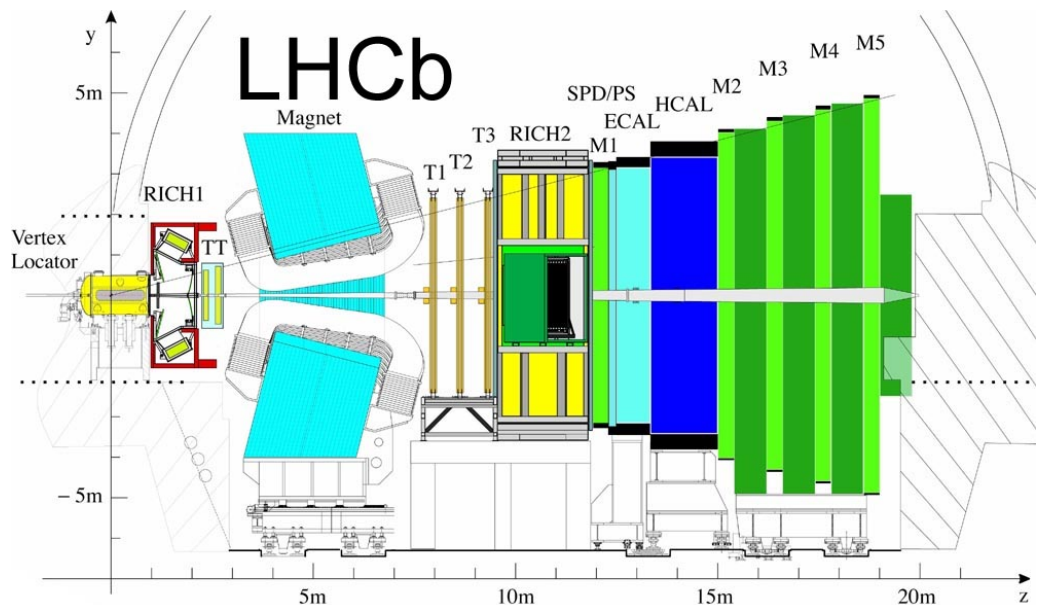

Recent Results from LHCb



LHCb is the first hadronic collider experiment which was optimized for b-quark physics. It had a very successful startup last year. With as

little as 1/100 of data to be collected in the next few years, competitive b-physics results have been already obtained. I will describe the detector design and performance, present the recent results and discuss its future potential.
